Australian College of Midwives (ACM)

Midwives attending this program are allocated **7.5 professional development credit points** under the Australian College of Midwives CPD Recognition program.



The Royal Australian College of General Practitioners (RACGP)

The Emergency Birthing program, activity number 155033 has been accredited with RACGP under the RACGP QI&CPD Program 2017-19. Participants of the workshop who are members of the college are eligible to claim **40 Accredited Category 1 points**. Additionally, this program has been approved for a **one-day Emergency, Anaesthetics or Obstetrics Rural Procedural Grant**.



Australian College of Rural and Remote Medicine (ACRRM)



Participants of the Emergency Birthing program (activity number 15879), who are members of ACRRM are eligible to claim **30 Practice Reflective Professional Development (PRPD) points, 30 Maintenance of Professional Standards (MOPS) points in Obstetrics and Gynaecology/Women's Health; and Emergency Medicine**. Additionally, members are eligible for a **one-day procedural grant under the obstetrics or emergency components**.

The Royal Australian and New Zealand College of Obstetricians and Gynaecologists (RANZCOG)

The Emergency Birthing program is in the process of application for CPD accreditation for RANZCOG Approved O&G Meetings. Upon approval, eligible fellows of this college will be able to claim **7.5 PD points** under the Clinical Expertise Domain.
