### HOW TO BOOK CHILDBIRTH EDUCATION ONLINE

# (PARKVILLE AND COMMUNITY VENUE WORKSHOPS)

#### Choosing your childbirth education program:

- We recommend that you book from 16 weeks and complete your childbirth education by 36 weeks gestation.
- The workshops are held at the Women's in Parkville on weeknights or weekends and in some community venues.
- If you come to the hospital for your childbirth education you only pay one amount of \$170. This means you need to book and pay for a weeknight or a Saturday series or an all-day workshop on a weekend.
- If you attend a program at one of the community venues you book and pay one amount of \$170 for 3 or 4 sessions (depending on the venue), with one of those sessions including a tour at the hospital. Make sure you select the correct venue for your postcode.

## If you are not attending childbirth education, you may still book a hospital tour

Other workshops available at the hospital:

- Caring for Yourself in Pregnancy (women only) and Talking Dads. Book as a bonus ticket once you have booked your childbirth education series/all-day workshop.
- A program for women expecting a multiple birth *Twins, triplets and more.* This is a 3 session series that includes a hospital tour.
- Non-English speaking programs in Mandarin and Vietnamese. If you need assistance when booking, please contact us.
