The Royal Women's Hospital is now offering our clients Childbirth and Early Parenting education, using video live-streaming for Women's clients experiencing their first labour.

You will have an experienced educator, offering advice and promoting discussion via a livestreaming platform. You will need to [download the Zoom app](#) (free) or use an online version in order to attend.

This will enable you to participate while still in the comfort of your own home.

This program will be conducted as either

- A three week series (one evening/week for three hours each) OR
- A two weekend mornings series (four hours per morning over two weekends).

Topics covered include:

- signs of labour, including when to come to hospital
- progress of labour and birth
- support in labour
- practical coping methods during labour
- medical options for pain management
- assistance with birth
- understanding breastfeeding
- safe sleeping and settling
- communicating with your baby
- community supports for the family
